
## Introduction

Daniel has his second dream in the third year of the reign of the Babylonian King Belshazzar. More information is forthcoming as God shares with His servant His plan for the future redemption of the world and the elimination of sin. Without equivocation, God is making it crystal clear that He is in Full control of all that takes place in the affairs of man. Daniel is given a dream that takes the prophet from his current day to the end of human dominion. It is interesting to note that scholars call Daniel 8-12 a collection of expansion prophecies – they build upon each other. Let's carefully study the message of Daniel 8 in this week's lesson as we review "Daniel's Second Dream."
