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
**Revelation 3:1**














## Sardis: Historical Application

AD 1798 - 1844

- Counter Reformation
- Council of Trent (AD 1545 1563)
  - Tradition and Scripture
  - Society of Jesus
    - Preterist
    - Futurist

• During this period, the vibrant generation of the Reformers who had awakened the church passed away. Their successors became more and more involved in fervent doctrinal polemics and controversies, gradually degenerating into lifeless formalism and spiritual lethargy. Toward the end of this period, under the impact of the rising tide of philosophical rationalism and secularism, the saving grace of the gospel and commitment to Christ waned, giving place to rationalism and theological arguments. The church of this period, although appearing to be alive, was in reality spiritually lifeless.
