





 - "We have believed and have come to know that You are the Holy One of God."




Philadelphia: The Problem

- Those who call themselves of God may attempt to close God's door.
 - Matt 23:13
 - Luke 11:52
- Though the door is open, and opposition may come the Lord himself will deal with enemies of the Gospel. It is up to us to focus on the call that God has given to us.



God's Promise

- He will keep those who keep
 - In what way?
 - c.f. John 17:15
- Those who dwell on the Earth
 - In Revelation refer to congregation of the ungodly. (c.f. Revelation 6:10, 8:13, 11:10, 13:8, 14; 14:6; 17:8)
- The Hour of Temptation/Trial
 - God's judgement against God's enemies





Philadelphia: The Counsel

- Rev. 3:12 Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name.
 - Rev. 3:13 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

- A Promise of Safety and Security
- A promise of New Permanent
 Name
 - The same reward in Revelation 14:1
 - The name that designates belonging
 - The name that is the City c.f. Ezekiel 48:35, Revelation 21:3
